STANDARDS - 150 & 250 SERIES

- Flush embossed hot dipped galvanized pre-painted steel with bonded wood grained molding outside on flush wood grained exterior (150 &250) with flush white stucco grained interior (250 Series), or vinyl back over polystyrene interior (150 Series).
- All steel construction including interior stiles and end stiles for maximum structural support.
- Heavy aluminum bottom retainer for extra strength for (250 Series), and (150 Series) with commercial grade vinyl retainer with thick vinyl weather strip runs the entire width of the bottom to conform with the floor and seal out the elements.
- Rugged hot dipped galvanized tracks, brackets, wide body hinges, and full steel ball bearing rollers. Torsion springs deliver years of trouble-free performance and continuous opening and closings.
- Backed by a limited lifetime warranty against splitting, cracking, and rust through.
- Wood moldings and overlays must be painted with 100% acrylic latex paint to seal primed overlays within 60 days of installation. Door sections can also be painted if desired with acrylic latex. DO NOT use oil based paint.
